Greenhouse Finished!

The greenhouse is finished and is already in service. We planted about 40 Colorado Blue Spruce tree seeds right into the ground, yet we are still experimenting to see if they will sprout up.

As we advance, the plan is that the greenhouse will act as a nursery for our tree seedlings to plant 1000 trees in Fountain in 2021. The below zero weather is not helping the cause :(, though we are determined to reach it!

Colorado Blue Spruce Seedlings

After a lengthy delay from the supplier, the tree seeds finally came in! So far, we have planted the 40 test seeds right into the greenhouse.

Also, we have 100 seeds in individual nursery bags waiting for them to sprout. We will need 1000 sprouts total to meet our 2021 goal.

The Colorado Blue Spruce matures at 50-75 feet and has a 10-20 foot spread. It likes full sun but needs at least six hours of direct, unfiltered sunlight each day. The tree can also provide privacy and a windbreak when planted in a row. Colorado Blue Spruce is identified by a silvery blue-green color year-round and is one of the most widely planted landscape trees in the state and the state tree of Colorado.

BioChar

BioChar is the process of burning wood material at high temperatures with little or no oxygen and enriching the char to produce a stable way of carbon storage that will significantly improve your garden. The process adds minerals and microbes which grow in the charcoal chambers over time.

A small handful of char is enough to enrich a large garden indefinitely over time. Furthermore, the use of biochar on a worldwide scale can reduce excess carbon from the atmosphere!

Charmaster (yes, Charmaster), Tony C. Saladino, helps us with the six-step, six-month process. He is extremely knowledgeable and has given us an in-depth overview of the process. We are very thankful for his help and support of his goal of an 80-acre outdoor school.
